MAINTAIN MAINTAIN - This summer we have two ministries that need maintenance assistance. So if you prefer odd jobs over construction, this is your opportunity.

The first is **FaHoCha Bible Camp** in eastern **North Dakota**. RV hookups are available or housing can be provided. Besides maintenance duties, everything from grounds keeping to kitchen help is needed.

Next we have **Cross Bar X Youth Ranch** in southwestern **Colorado**. They need a couple to come and assist with maintenance, office work, running errands to town, etc. There may also be opportunities to help with the camp programs. Typically they give volunteers a list of small maintenance projects that need to be accomplished and allow them to work at their own pace and schedule. If you feel the Lord's leading toward either of these, please contact Hard Hats for more detailed info.

Hard Hats has received a first-time request to work at **Heartstone Bible Camp** located in Northern **California**. This camp is only 15 miles from the Potter Valley project. Housing is available for craftsmen, families, and young people. In addition there are eight RV spots. The first phase of this project will include upgrading on 3 cabins including new siding, insulation, interior work, electrical, flooring, sheet rock, tape and paint. They also need help building and relocating a platform for a Yurt tent structure. The camp kitchen and dining building also need some new flooring and interior repairs. The second phase, depending on the permit, will include a complete exterior and interior renovation of an historic two story log cabin lodge at the Eel River. Be the first to volunteer.
