

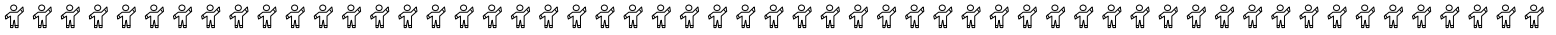

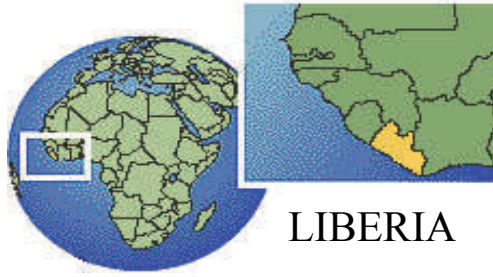
Bob and Shona Barnard, along with their kids, Anya and Sam, are "Kiwi missionaries" (New Zealanders) with Pioneers. They recently began a ministry to children in Mexico City after serving elsewhere in Mexico for 13 years.

A dishonest or, at least, ineffective if well-intentioned architect/contractor bilked them out of most of the money for their home and ministry center, leaving the project unfinished.

Hard Hats for Christ is partnering with our sister ministry "MMM" based in Australia and New Zealand, to finish the work for the Barnards.

Preliminary plans for sending teams in February 2010 are now being made.

Workers skilled in stucco, plaster, ceramic tile, tile roofing, finish carpentry and installation of windows (glass) and window security (metal working) are needed.



LIBERIA

Too long ago to remember, teams of Hard Hats built the campus of African Bible College in northwest Liberia.

A series of civil wars ravaged the country for decades, and in the process the buildings were gutted.

In the last couple of years, democracy and peace have been restored to the country, and groups such as Samaritan's Purse have funded the rebuilding of the campus.

Next year, ABC hopes to build their own radio and television studio, both to train students and to broadcast Gospel programming across Africa.

Hard Hats has been asked to help. This time, we hope to partner with MMM Africa and M M M A u s t r a l i a (www.mmm.org.au) to get the job done. We need American volunteers to hold up our end of the bargain! Won't you prayerfully consider a safari to Liberia in the fall of 2010?
