## A PLACE TO MEET GOD TEEN HARVEST, AVA, MISSOURI

This ranch is set up to help boys between the ages of 12 and 17, but everyone that shows up meets God there in some way. There are acres of land to explore, animals to care for and people to build relationships with. It is a God-centered family environment for boys who are struggling with what is going on in their lives. They are taught to study, play and work together.



As the boys are mentored to live lives that reflect God, their families at home are not forgotten. Each family is encouraged to come out to the ranch for recon-

ciliation retreats. Besides individual counseling, they provide family counseling. Whole families are encouraged to live their lives for God's glory.

One of their young men wrote: "Hello. My name is Zach. I came to Teen Harvest 7 months ago. The reason I came to Teen Harvest was because I got down the wrong path and walked away from the Lord. I was being a danger to my parents and society.

Well, after being at Teen Harvest for a week or two, I was seeing the love of God through everyone here and I wanted that love in me. So, on July 30, 2010 I rededicated my life to the Lord and I started showing Jesus'

light through me as it says in John 1:1-9.

When I am around my family now, they show me a lot of respect and they treat me like a mature adult instead of a rebellious teenager. That's just a little bit about what God is doing for me here at Teen Harvest."

They have projects all year round that can use a variety of skills. They have a bathroom that needs remodeled, a barn in need of restoration, and even vehicles that need repairs. This spring, March 31<sup>st</sup> – April 3<sup>rd</sup>, they are having a cabin building blitz. Not only will you have the opportunity to add to their facilities but to interact with boys like Zach as well.

This little church is located near the Columbia River. They are planning to add a kitchen, handicapped bathrooms and a fellowship area. Pray with them as

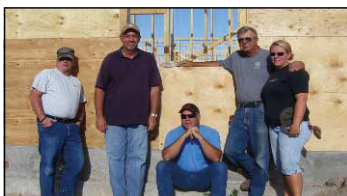
they wait for the architect to complete plans and work through the permit process. They would like to get started sometime this spring.

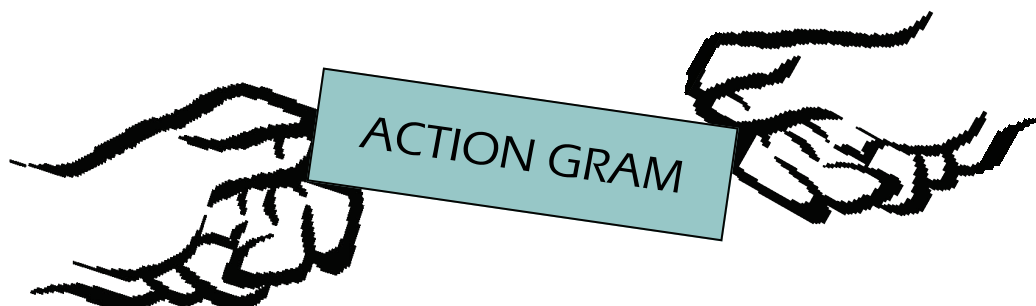
**CAMP LIVINGWATER**
